In 2018, after 38 years of practicing medicine at Ascension Columbia St. Mary's Hospital, Dr. Anthony Linn retired. Passionate about patient care, Dr. Linn was also very passionate about his team, especially the nursing staff. To honor his work and dedication, friends have established the Dr. Anthony Linn Nursing Education Fund.

This fund is designated as a monetary award for nurses involved in direct patient care to attend seminars, workshops, and professional organization's conferences that enhance their practice and the care of their patients. The expectation is that the nurse chosen for this award will share the knowledge gained with their co-workers.

One \$500 award will be given to one selected recipient per calendar year.

2019 Requirements

Applicants must be:

1. Registered nurses working at Ascension Columbia St. Mary's Hospital Milwaukee or Prospect Medical Commons.
2. A registered nurse employed by Ascension Columbia St. Mary's for three years providing direct patient care.
3. Willing to share knowledge gained with co-workers in a manner agreed upon with your manager/director.

Applicants must submit the following:

1. Completed application.
2. One letter of reference from your Ascension Columbia St. Mary's manager/director.
3. Copy of continuing education brochure.

Selection Process

Eligible candidates who submit all required items by the deadline will be considered. The typed statement will be evaluated on clarity, grammar, thoroughness, and thoughtfulness. The process may include an interview with the Selection Committee.
